My husband, Leni (an ordained priest) and I have lived in Christchurch for the last 23 years after moving here from Wellington. Over the last 10 and a half years I worked in the Parish of St. Barnabas, Fendalton, before spending a year at St. John the Evangelist College in Auckland where I completed my Diploma in Christian Studies.

In my ministry at St. Barnabas, I was made Lay Leader in 2008 and in 2009 I completed my CPE course.
