It's a real joy to welcome representatives of the Nurse Maude Association to our 9:30am service today. Each year we remember Nurse Maude in a special way, because of our connection with her. She is of course buried in our cemetery, and at the conclusion of the service we will lay a wreath on her grave. A remarkable person, Sibylla Emily Maude was a devoted Anglican



born in the family home here in the Parish in 1862. She is best remembered for her major advancements in the development of healthcare in our district.

Interestingly for us in this time of COVID-19, Maude advocated for the better treatment of those with the so-called Spanish flu, and due to her efforts the lives of many of Cantabrians were saved. She was buried after an enormous funeral on the 14th of July 1935.

The Gospel for today is easily relatable to the life of Nurse Maude. For a seed of compassion was instilled in her from a very early age. Despite some saying, "that nursing was not a suitable occupation for young women of gentle birth," she pioneered district nursing and the association which to this day works so hard, for so many, both here and in the Nelson area.

Has God planted a seed of compassion in your life?
