

Once when talking to the children a vicar asked the question "What's a saint?" Little Sarah answered, "A saint is someone who lets the light shine through them."

Today as we always do on All Saint's Day, we are recalling the lives of some of those in our prayer book calendar of saints. There is a Japanese man, an English woman, a Māori warrior and John the Baptizer. They are very different people from very different times and places and yet one thing unites them. They each allowed the light of Christ to shine through them. Notice the word *allowed*. They didn't have to do it in their own strength.

If we think, by trying harder and doing more, we are going to discover holiness, we are mistaken. Rather like a stained glass window our job is to let the light of the love of God shine through us. And like the stained glass of St Peter's we will be amazed at the beauty of that light.
