One of the misunderstandings about grief is that we can find closure. "If only I could get the body back," we hear on the news, "then I can have closure." If only, "they would say sorry, then I can have closure." If only...

There's 2 things wrong with these statements. Firstly we are relying on the actions of others to find healing. We are giving away our autonomy by relying on another actions, as if our healing depends on other

people. Secondly grief is never something we can close the book on. When we lose someone we love we always remember them. Over time the pain of loss becomes a little less, and we begin to discover joy again, but the memory is always there.

As we come to our annual remembrance service this weekend. We come not to forget our loss, but to give our loss over to God. To draw strength from each other knowing that we don't grieve alone but with others. God has not left us alone. God's love is greater than all kinds of death.

If you are trapped in grief, have a conversation with me because there is lots of help available. For all of us we need times to remember, to thank God for the memories, to hold them as sacred and to draw strength from the love of God and each other. This is not weakness but wisdom.
