

28th March 2021 Palm Sunday



Welcome to our Palm Sunday Services

We remember Our Lord Jesus being welcomed by the cheering crowd as he entered Jerusalem on the back of a donkey. We are given Palm crosses to commemorate this event and as sign of our discipleship. Just a few words about our celebration so you can be prepared.



At 9.30am we gather at the entrance of the Parish Hall under the veranda for the Liturgy of the Blessing of the

Palms (tree fern fronds). We then follow the donkey through the Lychgate beneath the yew trees to the Porch of the Church where we leave the donkey and enter. Children will accompany donkey followed by the choir in procession and congregation waving palms and singing "All glory, praise and honour." Some people might prefer not to process but wait in the Church.

At 8.00am there is no procession or donkey or Hymns but the whole service takes place in the Church.

At 8.00am and 9.30am communion will be as we have done in the past. We stand at the chancel step. The choir will go first. The congregation will come down the centre aisle and go to chancel step. After communion you return to your seat by the wall aisles after picking up a flax cross from the sides person standing by the pillars. There will be one patten with the breads but four chalices sharing half the imaginary communion rail (Chancel step).

Rieger's Return We are privileged to be hosting a recital from international concert organist Martin Setchell on Sunday 18th April at 2pm in St. Peter's. Martin is very generously donating his services as a fund-raiser tor



reinstallation of our organ. After 40 years as Associate Professor of Music at Canterbury University, in 2014 he resigned his position in order to devote himself full time to his work as a freelance professional musician, performing, writing, speaking, editing and teaching. Since 1997, when he was appointed curator of the Rieger pipe organ by the City Council, he has devoted himself to promoting the concert instrument organ as a internationally. In 2008 he was honoured by the city for his services to music and the Town Hall organ in particular. Significantly Martin helped St. Peter's acquire our organ through his contact with the Austrian makers and gave the first inaugural recital exactly 20 years ago in 2001. While there will be no charge for entry those attending will be invited to make a retiring donation, hopefully a generous one, in response to Martin's own ~ David Winfield generosity.
