

This is the Good News message at its finest. May the hope of the Risen Christ fill you with joy. May those of you who have lost loved ones know that this day reminds us we will be together again.



Can you imagine the despair of Mary, when broken-hearted she turns up at the tomb – only to find the stone rolled away. Not risen but stolen: but what transformation when the 'gardener' says her name, and her eyes are open! In Matthew's gospel the women ran from the tomb with fear and great joy. I find that very realistic – great joy – he's not dead: but fear – what does that mean?

My hope for you is that you can have a transforming encounter with Jesus this Easter: that you will know his radical forgiveness and love. Many of you already know the love, grace and mercy that comes from believing in the Easter story – go out from here this morning and show that love to the world: "Love one another as I have loved you."
