

Once upon a time a very wealthy and powerful king fell in love, from afar, with a poor maiden. But he knew that, in order to win her heart, he must forgo all his wealth and privilege. For if she knew him to be the king she would feel obliged to love him. So he took off his royal ring, dressed in filthy peasant clothes and began living in her village.



In time they did fall in love, and once convinced she truly loved him for who he is was, and not out of fear or for title or wealth, he asked her to marry him.

This story was told by the theologian Soren Kierkegaard to explain the process by which Jesus became one of us. Out of love he set aside all privilege, even though he was sovereign of the universe, to become human, in order that we might love him not out of obligation but with our hearts.

On this Christ the King Sunday this is the sort of king Jesus is. He empties himself of all power and wealth and, looking just like us, does not oblige us to love him out of fear but from our hearts.
