Teach us to pray

This was the request the disciples made of Jesus in today's Gospel. It was a bit rude, because he was actually praying at the time and they interrupted him. And it was a bit strange because the disciples as faithful Jews would have been already been praying all their lives. But there was a quality in Jesus' praying that made them want to know more.



Jesus gives them a template for prayer, what we call The Lord's Prayer. More a template than a formula, Jesus begins in this prayer a religious revolution. This revolution centres on the word he uses for God. Abba. Abba is the most intimate word a child had for their father, we might say Daddy. Until Jesus, God had been a long way off, to be feared, the sovereign of the universe. In fact so fearful was the name of God that Jews never say it.

Jesus has and wants us to have an intimate life giving relationship with the God he called Daddy. This revolution begins with the Lord's Prayer .
