As you look back over your life you may find the focus of what is most important to you has changed as you get older, as you had a family or found your passion in life. Would you rather spend a day with that precious grandchild, or yet another day in the office making money for his or her future?



In this week's gospel Jesus tells a story about a successful farmer who has to build bigger barns to store his grain – and then thinks he has done all he needs to do in life. His security is in his possessions. Jesus challenges this.

We are not being asked to give up all our possessions, but to see them in perspective. The wise person is the one who is "rich toward God," which means generous towards others in need. That is, we are told to love our neighbour, look after the marginalised and those less fortunate than us. We need to share God's abundant gifts with those in need and put our faith in the riches of the world for which Jesus saved us, not earthly riches.
