The position we have in society gets forgotten because God treats all his family as important and equal. PLANT SALE

Only seven weeks to the October Plant Sale (Oct 15th). There is still time to pot up plants- if the recent wet weather allows -but they need to be done soon to allow time to establish. Some of the most popular plants are alstroemeria, begonias, hostas, chrysanthemums, begonias, peonies, strawberries, geraniums, etc. Pot up no more than 6-8 of each variety, name each plant and its flower-colour if possible. Dahlia tubers and gladioli corms can be either potted up - or bagged and labelled in their dormant state.

Please do not pot up SMALL hellebores, delphiniums or heuchera

- they are not really saleable.

Potting mix is available at St. Peter's, in the Potting Shed (by the Garage), along with a big range of pots.
