

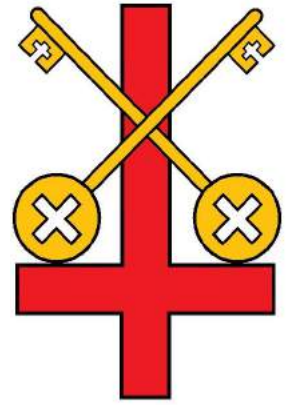

The greening of our lives

One of my favourite traditions at St Luke's and St Peter's at Easter is the greening of the cross. The bare wooden cross, which is so much a symbol of pain, shame and death, is transformed by our greenery and flowers into a symbol of new life and hope. It's lovely to see the children reaching up to place a flower or a branch, the old helping the young and vice versa and a flower shared with a visitor. It also speaks about community and how together we can make a big difference even if our own contribution is small.



With the raising of Jesus from death on Easter morning the world was transformed forever. No longer does death hold sway but the power of God's love is present for all to see.

Like all good symbols the greened cross doesn't really need any explanation. And looking at the photos of the cross that Victory congregation did last Sunday it's a symbol that speaks across cultures too. My prayer for you this Easter is that you will delight. Delight in the Risen Christ. Delight in the hope Jesus brings and delight in all the uplifting symbols of our Easter faith.

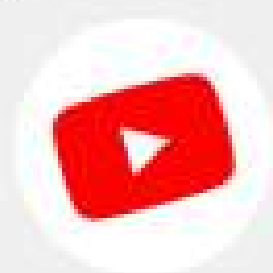

**International organist Colin Andrews
plays Bach, Bonnet, Frank, Widor & Messiaen
on the St Peter’s Rieger organ**

Colin Andrews was born in Bristol England. He studied at The Royal Academy of Music in London and at The Conservatoire de Muisque in Geneva, Switzerland. His principal Professors were Lionel Rogg and Dame Gillian Weir. Mr Andrews was a prizewinner at both the 1980 & 1982 Dublin International Organ Competitions in Ireland. In 1993, The Royal Academy of Music in London bestowed an Associateship upon him in recognition of his distinguished performing career. Mr. Andrews has toured worldwide as a concert organist, undertaking multiple tours of Asia, Europe and trans-continental tours of Russia. He has performed in all of the major concert halls in Asia, including Suntory Hall, Tokyo, Esplanade Theaters-on-the-Bay, Singapore, Beijing National Center for the Performing Arts, Shanghai Oriental Arts Center, Sydney Town Hall, Australia, Auckland Town Hall, New Zealand etc.

Other concert venues have included The Royal Festival Hall, London, King's College, Cambridge, The Cathedral of Notre-Dame, Paris (3 appearances), The Moscow Conservatoire, The St. Petersburg Philharmonic Hall & Mariinsky Theatre Concert Hall, St. Petersburg, Russia, The National Convention
