### A generous fold

It's a beautiful image. Jesus the good shepherd. Protecting, caring, nurturing. In fact it's the original pastoral care. We have lots of lovely hymns about the good shepherd, although none that I could find about Jesus the gate! We have churches named after Jesus the good shepherd, and striking stained glass windows (see if you can find the one in St Peter's).



But like the sheep that farmers look after we are in danger of domesticating Jesus. The shepherds of Jesus day were very different from the farmers of today. They lived 24/7 with their sheep, unable to keep the Jewish law, often women or boys, poor, they smelt really bad and the rest of society looked down on them. By saying he is the good shepherd Jesus is aligning himself with the outcast. But then that shouldn't come as a surprise, that's exactly what he did by naming the Samaritan good!

Jesus does care, protect and nurture us, but not at the cost of excluding others.



# International organist Colin Andrews plays Bach, Bonnet, Frank, Widor & Messiaen on the St Peter's Rieger organ

Colin Andrews was born in Bristol England. He studied at The Royal Academy of Music in London and at The Conservatoire de Muisque in Geneva, Switzerland. His principal Professors were Lionel Rogg and Dame Gillian Weir. Mr Andrews was a prizewinner at both the 1980 & 1982 Dublin International Organ Competitions in Ireland. In 1993, The Royal Academy of Music in London bestowed an Associateship upon him in recognition of his distinguished performing career. Mr. Andrews has toured worldwide as a concert organist, undertaking multiple tours of Asia, Europe and trans-continental tours of Russia. He has performed in all of the major concert halls in Asia, including Suntory Hall, Tokyo, Esplanade Theaters-on-the-Bay, Singapore, Beijing National Center for the Performing Arts, Shanghai Oriental Arts Center, Sydney Town Hall, Australia, Auckland Town Hall, New Zealand etc. Other concert venues have included The Royal Festival Hall, London, King's College, Cambridge, The Cathedral of Notre-Dame, Paris (3 appearances), The Moscow Conservatoire, The St. Petersburg Philharmonic Hall & Mariinsky Theatre Concert Hall, St. Petersburg, Russia, The National Convention
