

The Grace to Reconcile

In our Gospel for Sunday, Matthew 18:15-20, we find a profound message of reconciliation (which means to restore relationships which are broken or stressed) and being community within our Christian faith. This passage emphasises the importance of facing conflicts and seeking resolution within the community of believers. Jesus encourages his followers to approach one another with love and humility, making every effort to restore relationships that may have been strained. The image of being the Family of God is

The passage also reminds us that when two or more gather in God's name, God's presence is felt, underlining the significance of community and unity in the pursuit of God's love and guidance. It's a beautiful reminder of the inclusivity and love that God calls us to embrace in our journey of faith.

Prayer for this Sunday's theme: God of peace and light. May our churches be places where quarrels can be settled, where prayer draws us together and where love can grow. Through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen**.
