

### We want to make the intersections around Church Corner way safer for everyone.


We know that 55% of crashes in Christchurch happen at intersections. Slowing down traffic through intersections reduces both the number and severity of crashes. It also means drivers can watch out for others and stop quickly.

When everyone travels a bit slower, people feel safer walking, scootering or biking to get around instead of using their car.

We've worked hard to get a draft plan ready for community input – if you regularly use these intersections, we want to hear your feedback on our planned safety improvements.

#### The safety improvements we're planning include:

- road layout changes
- · safe speed platforms
- · on-road cycle lanes
- pedestrian crossings
- speed humps
- parallel parking
- more accessible bus stops.
