

This was a saying that our grandparents could have said. But when it comes to grieving our loved ones the church takes a different approach. This Sunday we have our annual remembering the departed services. It's an opportunity to bring flowers, to light a candle and to name aloud those we remember. It might be someone who has died this year or any year.



Every time we gather for Eucharist there is part of the Prayers of The People that remembers those that have died. Not because we have to remind God about them, but that its healing for us to regularly remember them. To remind ourselves of the hope we have in eternal life and to reassure us of the trust we can place in God.

The media often talks about closure. But we never close the book on our grief. Rather by gently remembering them in a supportive community like ours, the pain over the years lessens. The hope in eternal life that we gain through Jesus' death and resurrection is a unique gift of our faith, and one that grows as we remember our departed loved ones today.

May they rest in peace and rise in glory.






